

Responsibility and Role Models in an Intercultural Perspective

This interdisciplinary conference brings together German and Japanese experts in cultural and moral philosophy, sociology, and educational research whose work deals with responsibility in an intercultural perspective. In terms of cultural and moral philosophy, the following questions will be posed: How do forms of attributing responsibility differ in different cultures? What role do social, legal and other culturally different aspects play? What role do categories such as gender play? Sociologically and educationally, the role model functions of various groups of people in the media as well as in the school context in Germany and Japan will be concretely integrated. In addition to the lectures, there will also be a round table (non-public) with teachers who will report from their experience and engage in conversation with the researchers.
